Backline Requirements:

Drums (left handed!)

First weapons of choice, mentioned in following order are Pearl, Yamaha, DW (Drum Workshop) and Premier

When not available any other professional brand in the same quality range, that meets the same performance as

above mentioned brands will suffice.

The drumkit must at least contain following sizes and stands:

Bassdrum: 22", no smaller size!! Floortoms: 16" and 18 (or 14" and 16") When only one floortom an extra tom size 12" is needed

Snaredrum: 14", at least 5" deep Toms: 13" (mounted on a snarestand)

Hardware: kickpedal, hihat stand, 2x snaredrum stands, 5x boomstand (but at least 3x!), drumstool, drum rug, 2x microphone boomstands

Cymbals: 1x 14" hihat set (bottom and top), at least 2x crashes 16" (or 17") and 18", 1x ride 20"

Guitar:
